1 On October 9, 2020, Plaintiffs filed a Motion for Attorneys’ Fees and Costs and Class  
2 Representatives’ Service Awards (the “Motion”). (See ECF No. 117.) In response, Defendants  
3 Bumble Trading Inc. and Bumble Holding Ltd. (together “Bumble”) submit this written Statement of  
4 Nonopposition (“Non-Opposition”) pursuant to Civil Local Rule 7-3(b).

5 Bumble does not oppose Plaintiffs’ Motion. Bumble notes for the Court, however, that the  
6 requested attorneys’ fees are higher than Bumble anticipated. Counsel for Plaintiffs have requested  
7 \$6,075,000 or 27% of the settlement fund, (see ECF No. 117 at 2), which exceeds the Ninth Circuit’s  
8 25% benchmark for settlements involving a common fund. Plaintiffs have also asserted that they spent  
9 over 4,500 hours litigating this case, which appears high given the limited amount and asymmetric  
10 nature of discovery conducted in this case. Specifically, discovery involved only one half-day  
11 deposition, and because this case hinged on Bumble’s Terms and in-app screens, only a few hundred  
12 documents were produced throughout the course of the litigation. Further, at 4,500 hours, Plaintiffs  
13 purport to have worked significantly more than (almost 1.7x) the total hours Bumble’s outside counsel  
14 spent on this litigation.
